This means you need to explore the range of skills that counsellors use in practice including the therapeutic conditions counsellors try to offer clients and the potential barriers to the therapeutic relationship.

You must assess the value of the following skills;

- a) Non-judgemental responses
- b) Open and closed questions
- c) Paraphrasing
- d) Summarising
- e) Reflecting feelings
- f) Use of silence
- g) Immediacy
- h) Non-verbal communication

To provide a true assessment of the value of these skills you should consider how each skill is used in counselling practice and the impact of the skill on the counselling relationship (1.1).

You must also **discuss** how internal and external barriers to communication can impinge on listening skills (1.2) and give examples to illustrate how you could **develop** strategies to minimise the impact of internal and external barriers on listening skills (1.3)

The qualities of the counselling relationship should be explored. You must **discuss** the meaning of; (3.1)

- a) Empathic understanding
- b) Unconditional positive regard
- c) Congruence (genuineness)

Your report should be word processed in an academic style following the guidance from your tutor. Appropriately referenced material should be included making use of the Harvard referencing style.
