



## Flowchart for the grading of the Access to HE Diploma

One Awards assigns grade descriptors (GD) to each unit, GD 7 (Quality) plus at least one other Assessment plan for the Diploma and each unit developed and internally moderated Assessors write assignment brief(s) for the units including the components of the grade descriptors which have been chosen for that assignment. GD 7, plus one other must be used. These are internally moderated. Are drafts permitted?
